Passion WaVe @ Jurong Lake Gardens

ActiveSG Park @ Jurong Lake Gardens



Operated by SportSG, this sports facility includes an indoor gym and an outdoor lap pool with views of the gardens.

Forest Ramble



Suitable for 5- to 12-year-olds, this sprawling 2.3 ha nature playgarden has 13 exciting stations that allow children to mimic the natural movements of our native wildlife!

SkatePark @ Lakeside Garden



SkatePark @ Lakeside Garden is the biggest outdoor skate park in Singapore, and the first with a parkour park and bouldering wall.

Operating hours: 8 am to 10 pm, Tue to Sun

Nature

Grasslands



Surround yourself in a field of tall grasses or take shelter in the bird hides to observe the wildlife that lives here.

Please note that as there are no lights in this nature area, visitors are advised not to enter after dark.

Rasau Walk



Take a stroll on this meandering boardwalk along the water's edge, and enjoy the dense variety of plants that thrive along the restored freshwater habitat.

Rainforest Pavilion



Rainforest Pavilion houses a café that offers food and beverages, skate retail services and recreational programming for the skating community.

Allotment Gardens



Flex those green fingers with your own plot at the Allotment Gardens, Singapore's largest of its kind. Hone your skills, grow your own greens, such as herbs, edibles and ornamental plants, and meet with other like-minded gardeners within this vibrant community.
