

## ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS ON ISSUE OF LICENCE FOR FARM FOR ORNAMENTAL BIRD FARMS

The Animal & Veterinary Service ("AVS") is a cluster of the National Parks Board, a statutory board constituted under the National Parks Board Act (Cap. 198A).

## ORNAMENTAL BIRD FARM BIOSECURITY MEASURES

- 1. Entire perimeter of the farm must be completely fenced.
- 2. All persons entering the production areas must either undergo appropriate biosanitation or outfitted with appropriate protective clothing, including boots and face masks to prevent introduction of diseases.
- 3. The entrance to a production area shall be equipped with effective vehicular disinfection facilities.
- 4. Foot-dips with sufficient and appropriate disinfectant for disinfection shall be provided at the entrances of each bird house. The disinfectant should also be changed regularly to maintain its effectiveness.
- 5. Bird houses must be bird-proofed.
- 6. The farm must have a system for the proper disposal of dead birds, manure, and other wastes from the farm as required by AVS and other relevant authorities.
- 7. The farm must have an effective pest control measures in place.
- 8. Access to the production area is restricted to farm workers and essential business visitors only e.g. visits by business visitors/partners, and contractors for repair and maintenance of farm equipment.
- 9. A record must be kept of all visitors to the farm, production area and bird houses.
- 10. Bird mortality, breeding and bird movements must be recorded and maintained to assist monitoring for unusual animal health problems and facilitate tracing in case of an outbreak.
- 11. All visitors should park their vehicles outside the production area unless it is essential that the vehicle be taken on site e.g. maintenance contractors.
- 12. Farms must be free from unwanted vegetation and debris that could attract and harbour pests and wild birds.
