REVISION OF IMPORT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE IMPORT OF LABORATORY ANIMALS - PRIMATES INTO SINGAPORE WITH EFFECT FROM 2 FEBRUARY 2022

The Veterinary Conditions for the Importation of Laboratory Animals - Primates will be revised with effect from 2 February 2022 following a risk assessment to ensure the safe import of non-human primates.

- 3 Importers should ensure that import of laboratory specimens of NHPs comply with this revised veterinary condition from 2 February 2022 onwards.
