



Anderson Primary School Community in Nature Initiatives



As part of the **Greening Schools for Biodiversity** programme, the Art club and GAIA club members have planted native plants into the garden, and introduced indoor plants like the *Fittonia* mix into our common toilets.



Periodically, NParks conducts **horticulture sessions** for our GAIA club members. They learnt how to propagate some of the native plants within the school.



Every year, our GAIA club members take part in **BioBlitz**, an activity where they conduct a biodiversity audit of the school. After taking photos using iPads, they will upload their findings to Padlet, an online sharing platform.



As part of our **community efforts**, the GAIA club members engaged the public at Ang Mo Kio Hub during Ecofiesta on 14th Sept 2019. They taught the public how to make self-watering planters using indoor plants and recycled bottles. Professor Yaacob Ibrahim (former MP for Jalan Besar GRC) and Ms Denise Phua (Mayor of Central Singapore District) visited our workshop and affirmed our students' good work for the environment.



Through our **Science curriculum**, our P3 students get to grow sustainable food crops using hydroponics while our P5 students get to mix their own soil and grow their own vegetables through a micro-farming workshop.
