Pollinators are essential to the reproduction of many agriculturally important plants or they are indispensable to the conservation of wild plant populations or they facilitate gene flow between our remaining forest fragments, thereby maintaining genetic and promoting resilience against the effects of climate change.

Ashy Roundleaf Bat (*Hipposideros cineraceus*) and
Horsfield's Myotis (*Myotis horsfieldii*).

Gold-margined Stingless Bee (*Lepidotrigona terminata*).
