

18.1. Print Certificate

System allows licensee to print watermark certificate(s) based on the following conditions:

- Selected licence allows printing with watermark.
- The machine used to generate the licence has a compatible watermark printer connected.
- To prevent print count from being used up, system will detect connected printers and displays list of watermark printer(s) for selection before printing.

For watermark supporting document, please ensure the content in the document is embedded within A4 size (Width: 21cm, Height: 29.7cm), with transparent background and kept within the recommended default margin (Top: 1.9 cm, Bottom: 1.9 cm, Right: 1.8 cm, Left: 1.8 cm)

Document should be with transparent background. Some examples of non-transparent background:

- The fully scanned document will be in the form of image so it will overlap the watermark print even it is in the PDF format.
- The documents with background colour will overlap the watermark print.
- The documents with coloured table cells will overlap the watermark print.

For signatures, applicant can use digital signatures at the bottom of the documents so that it won't overlap with watermark print.

CITES PERMIT CONDITIONS

- All import/export/re-export must be in compliance with CITES and N Parks' regulations. This CITES permit is issued in pursuant to the Endangered Species (Import and Export) Act (ESA). Any import/export/re-export of species not under and in accordance with ESA is an offence under Section 4(1) of the Act, and offender shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$50,000 for each species (but not to exceed in the aggregate \$500,000) or to an imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years or to both, and forfeiture of the consignment.
- This CITES permit is valid for one consignment only.
- This CITES permit is valid only:
 - when it is used for import, export or re-export within the validity period of the permit.
 - if it bears the signature of an authorised officer and stamp of N Parks.
 - if the species it covers matches the species in the consignment.
 - if the quantity of each species in the consignment is equal to or less than the quantity of the corresponding species stated on the permit.
- If this CITES permit is issued for export or re-export for live animals, it shall be valid only if the transport conditions comply with the CITES Guidelines for transport and preparation for transport of wild animals and plants (CITES Guidelines for transport) or, in the case of air transport, with the International Air Transport Association or IATA Live Animals Regulations.
- This CITES permit and the species it covers may be subject to inspection by an authorised inspector prior to or at the time the consignment is affected, and at a place as specified by the authorised inspector. All relevant supporting documents, including the originals of the CITES import/export/re-export permits, must be presented to the authorised inspector for verification and endorsement during the inspection. The authorised inspector may refuse to endorse or release the consignment if he is not satisfied with the supporting documents or if the consignment is in contravention of any conditions specified on the permit.
- For import consignment, the foreign CITES import/re-export permit and CITES import permit issued by N Parks must be valid at the point of import. The original CITES export/re-export permit from the country of export/re-export must be surrendered to N Parks for retention and cancellation immediately after inspection or Customs clearance of consignment.
- This CITES permit is valid only if the specimens are marked in accordance with the specification as directed by N Parks. The identification numbers (eg, microchip) of the specimens must match those on the tag list accompanying the permit.
- This CITES permit is not transferable and shall not be valid for import/export/re-export of species other than used by the permittee or his/her agent.
- Any unused or expired CITES permit and certificate issued by N Parks must be returned to N Parks for cancellation. There is no refund for any unused or expired permit or certificate.
- The original CITES export/re-export permit issued by N Parks shall accompany the consignment to the destination. Export/re-export endorsement shall only be done on Box 15 of the original CITES export/re-export permit.
- Any breach of conditions of the CITES permit or contravention of the ESA and would render this permit null and void. Failure to comply with any of the conditions of the CITES permit or contravention of goods or rejection of import/export/re-export and follow up action could be taken against the permittee and/or his/her agent.
- The permittee or his/her agent must ensure that correct documentation accompany the import/export/re-export consignment.
- This CITES permit does not exempt the permittee from the provisions of other applicable legislation. The permittee should ensure that all necessary permits/licenses/certificates required under other laws or regulations are obtained.

What to do if there is printing error?

Contact NParks Wildlife Trade team to reset print count

- Email NParks with the error screenshot or photo of printer jam etc.
- Reset print count is non-chargeable
- Note: there is control to the number of print count reset as printing multiple copies of the same CITES permit is not allowed
- If there are still printing errors after reset of print count (up to 2 times), please collect the printout from NParks. Please try to print another new permit after the printing issue is resolved.


