Kranji Marshes is a marshland located in the neighbourhood of Sungei Buloh reservoirs. It is jointly developed in collaboration with Urban Redevelopment Authority (URA), National Parks Board (NPARKS) and Water Resource Agent of the Public Utilities Board (PUB). Dubbed as the largest fresh water marshland in Singapore, it is home to more than 54 species of butterflies, 33 species of dragonflies and 170 species of birds. The Marshland is estimated to occupy an area of 56.8 ha. Kranji Marshes serves as a rest hub for the Round Island Route (RIR) and is also a conservation area, promoting Kranji's rich history.

# MAINTENANCE Public and Urban Spaces

Approaching the Gardens by road, it is easy to be awe-struck by the stretches of colour and impact of feature plants flashing past our sight. As we slow down and appreciate the details, it is easy to understand the challenges and care needed to keep these stretches looking their best. While most streetscape plants are trimmed mechanically into hedges and boxes, the plants here are selectively pruned, individually cared for and allowed to take their natural forms. The golden rain trees set the tone for unique planting scheme along the verge; special attention is given to ensure they receive the best nourishment and treatment. The main entrance is an integral part of the garden, giving visitors a prelude to the exciting gardens ahead and a lasting memory when they leave.

The architecture and landscape of the house are of an Asian tropical design concept with its wooden ceiling and a unique entrance to the house. This provides an opportunity to create a lush tropical pathway to the main door of the house. With an age old Plumeria "Alba" at the main gate that leads along the passage with Heliconia marginata, Musa and other tropical plants to welcome their guests to this exotic surrounding. The patio is draped with the creeper Vernonia elliptica along the roof that partly expose the garden with two mature trees, Dalbergia oliveri and Bucida molineti. The poolside is planted with a variety of trees to represent the diversity of this garden as well as to provide privacy to the family. The second level overlooks beautiful greenery grown on the car porch and patio roof. This landscape was designed to be a private hidden tropical garden scene.
