T4. CALL TOPIC 4

T4.1 What do "biogeochemical processes" refer to in Call Topics 4 and 5? (5 February 2022)

Call Topics 4 and 5 focuses on all biogeochemical processes, including but not limited to Carbon and Sulfur cycles, that drive important changes in the ocean and lead to different oceanic states (e.g., oceanic acidification states) which may negatively impact marine ecosystems.
