Fernery gardens have a more natural ambience as compared to other gardens. Fernery gardens tend to do well in shady environments instead of sunny and open areas. The different textures of the ferns also complement and blend in well with each other.

Growth Conditions for Fernery Gardens

Light Requirement 
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ferns tend to thrive under a shady environment.• Some ferns can take partial sun.

Water Requirement 
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ferns require moderate watering for them to thrive.

Soil Requirement 
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Well-drained soil that does not cause waterlogging

Fertilising Regime
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fertilise when needed

Recommended Plants



Maidenhair Fern
(*Adiantum latifolium*)
Height: 0.6m – 0.9m




Asian Spikemoss
(*Selaginella plana*)
Height: 0.2m – 0.6m




Bird's Nest Fern
(*Asplenium nidus*)
Height: 0.2m-0.4m





Tree Fern
(*Cyathea latebrosa*)
Height: 1m – 4m




Boston Fern
(*Nephrolepis exaltata*)
Height: 0.6m – 0.9m




Staghorn Fern
(*Phytocrium coromarium*)
Height: 0.2 – 0.5m
