

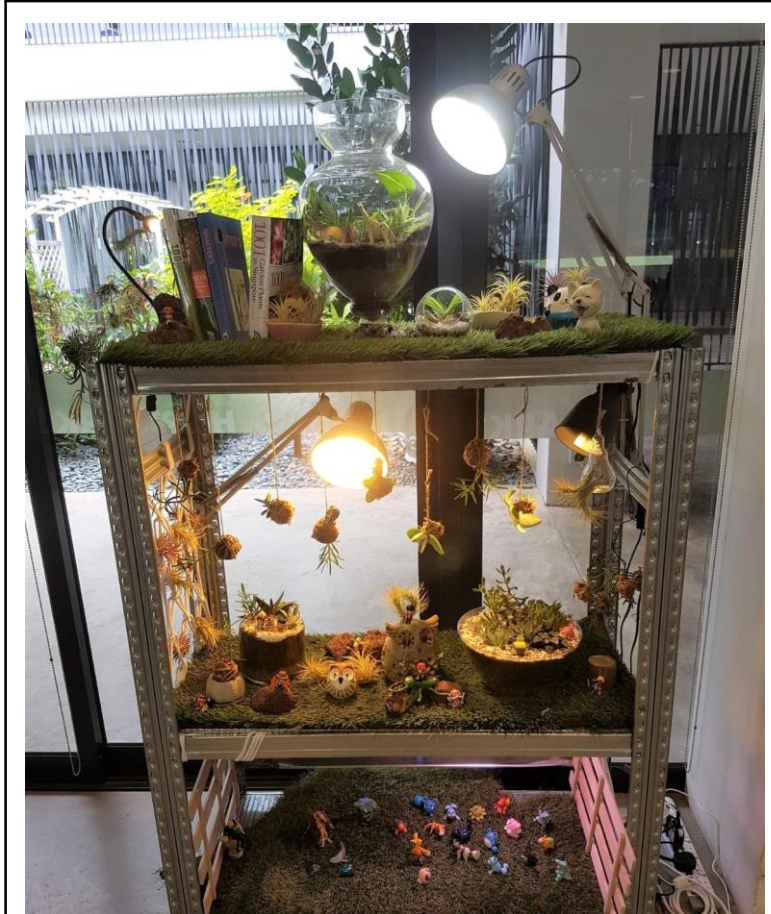
COMMUNITY IN BLOOM AWARDS 2021

Instructions

- a) Submission of **3 to 5 photographs** per CIB group is allowed.
- b) Photographs submitted must be the participant's own work and must be taken in the CIB garden.
- c) Photos that have won prizes in other photography competitions, or have been previously used or are intended to be used for any kind of commercial purposes, must not be submitted
- d) Digital manipulation that distorts the reality of the photographs is not allowed. Only basic enhancements such as sharpening, contrast adjustment, converting colour images to black and white are allowed.
- e) Each photograph entry must be submitted digitally in JPEG format and no larger than **3 MB** in JPEG format.
- f) Each photograph entry will require a caption with not more than **50** words
- g) All entries must be submitted online to <https://go.gov.sg/ciba2021registration>


