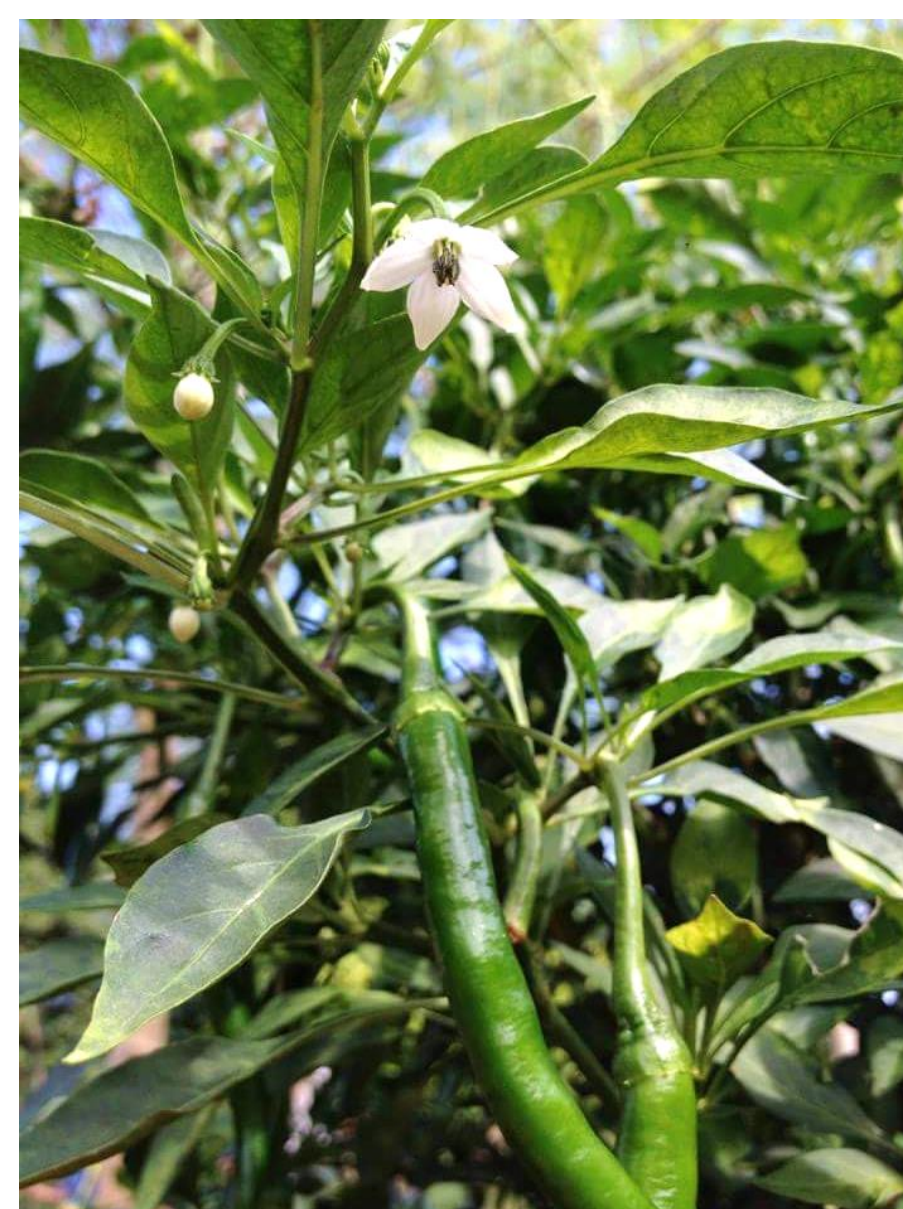


Making Good Slaves of Your Plants
