


PARK REGULATIONS

VISITOR GUIDELINES

Before you begin your journey of discovery, here are some tips to help make visits to Pulau Ubin safe and pleasant for everyone:

- Exercise responsibility for your own personal safety.
- Consult the National Parks Board if you are planning a group activity. Refrain from setting up any markers, checkpoints or signs without authorisation. Application for park usage is required for the following: -organised groups of more than 40 people -ticketed events

-events requiring structural set-up or amplified sound systems Send your request to NParks_Pulau_Ubin@nparks.gov.sg

- Use only designated paths, trails, roads, tracks and boardwalks. Please keep to your left so as not to obstruct others.
- If cycling, put on protective gear and ensure your bicycle is in good working condition before setting off. When cycling downhill or negotiating a bend, switch to a lower gear and slow down by braking gently.
- For your safety, stay out of closed areas and keep away from the edges of granite quarries, ponds and rivers.

- Water from public toilets is not suitable for drinking or bathing. Please note that shower facilities are not available at public toilets.
- Light fires only at designated campfire pits. Do not leave your fire unattended and make sure it is completely extinguished before leaving the campsite. • Be considerate and take good care of facilities on the island so that others can also
- enjoy them. Appreciate the sounds of nature and respect other park users by keeping noise levels
- Observe and appreciate wildlife from a distance.
- Hornets and wild bees are potentially dangerous when disturbed stay clear of any nest or hive and report its location to the National Parks Board.
- Apply insect repellent to protect yourself against mosquitoes and sandflies.
