


Children imitated the movement of their favourite animals during their gross motor lesson.


Children took turns to draw a picture card from the Mystery box and talked about it.







Introducing the book provided by NParks. Children were able to id entify the native animals seen alo ng the park connectors.






The children used their cameras to capture interesting plants and animals at the park.
