



SINGAPORE GARDEN FESTIVAL 2014 GARDENERS' CUP 2014

Competition Background

Singapore Garden Festival (SGF) 2014 brings back a key event, the Community in Bloom (CIB) Gardeners' Cup 2014, a friendly garden display competition among the CIB groups in Singapore.

Local participants from various groups and organisations are grouped into **five teams** for this competition, according to their districts within Singapore. The overarching theme for the competition is **"Fiesta"** and each team is given the challenge to set up garden displays that evokes one of the following five senses – **Hear, Sight, Taste, Touch and Smell**.

The teams have brought the theme to life with innovative and creative ideas including building their own special structures or using plants they have grown themselves. The five teams will be vying for the Gardeners' Cup 2014 Championship trophy, and four special award titles: Innovative Award, Biodiversity Award, Educational Award and Best Theme Award. The winners will be announced at the Singapore Garden Festival Awards Ceremony on 15 August 2014.
