Information on co-created works of art by Kenny Leck and Royston Tan



Kenny Leck (陆文良) Literary | Theme: Childhood

Kenny Leck is the co-founder of BooksActually, an independent literary bookstore. He also helms the publishing imprint Math Paper Press, and the handmade stationery line, Birds & Co. Both an artist and collector, Kenny's most characteristic art works are boxed assemblages created from found objects.

Kenny has gathered a team of 10 local writers – Annaliza Bakri, Alvin Pang, Cyril Wong, Hao Guang, Ian Chung, Jennifer Anne Champion, Joshua Ip, Pooja Nansi, O Thiam Chin and Verena Tay – to craft poems and prose, inspired by SG Heart Map contributions relating to the theme of childhood. The literary works will be showcased at SG Heart Map @ Park, in conjunction with NParks' SG50 Concert Series in the Park on 14 March 2015.



Royston Tan (陈子谦) Film | Theme: Romantic Moments

Royston Tan has been heralded as Singapore's most promising young filmmaker. Known for his distinctive knack for cinematic narrative, original directorial style and an innate ability to connect with his audience, Royston has collected over 60 international and local film awards.

Inspired by the notion of romance, Royston draws stories from SG Heart Map to present 50 First Kisses, a short film on places in Singapore that bear romantic significance to couples. Drawing from heartwarming and candid recollections from Singaporeans, in particular the Pioneer Generation, Royston's film explores the intimate moments of Singaporeans from all walks of life, set against the backdrop of iconic landmarks in Singapore. 50 First Kisses will
