For projects that are listed as "Viewable from street level", please enjoy the installations from the common/public spaces at street level. You are not allowed to enter the premises without permission.

For projects that are listed as "Walk on me", these projects are fully accessible to the public.

At each site do remember to take nothing but photos, leave nothing but footprints!

DIFFICULTY OF TRAIL

The trails are of easy to moderate levels. You may alight at the nearest MRT station and walk (unless stated otherwise) to the various projects listed

ESTIMATED TIME OF COMPLETION OF THIS TRAIL

You will take about 2–3 hours to complete this trail. It is necessary to take public/ private transport to some of these projects in order to complete all projects within this time frame, excluding viewing time at each site.


WHAT IS SKYRISE GREENERY?

Skyrise Greenery is a term coined in Singapore that refers to the greening of both horizontal (rooftop greenery) and vertical (green walls) dimensions.

These installations can be spotted all around Singapore in various forms such as sky terraces, balcony planters, green roofs, rooftop gardens and different types of green walls.

WHY IS SKYRISE GREENING NECESSARY?

In our heavily built-up city-state with limited land, skyrise greenery helps to create a harmonious balance between urban development and our natural heritage. It also helps reduce the Urban Heat Island effect, making Singapore a more liveable place.

01. BREADTALK HQ





Various vertical greenery installations can be found indoors at the food and beverage area on the first floor. Uniquely integrated into the wall facades, these installations allow patrons of the eateries to enjoy their meals amid greenery.

02. TEMASEK POLYTECHNIC - SOUTH WING





Segments of vertical greenery can be spotted on the walls of the Temasek Polytechnic South Wing (Blk 26B). They help to break the monotony of the facade and enhance the building's aesthetic appearance.


03. TEMASEK POLYTECHNIC – SINGAPORE INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY





This vertical greenery installation spanning three storeys can be found at Blk 29B near the lift lobby, providing green relief for students and staff.

04. CHANGI GENERAL HOSPITAL





Two vertical greenery installations can be found at the drop-off point near lift lobby B and the outpatient entrance near lift lobby A, providing green relief from the sterile environment of the wards.

05. CHANGI CITY POINT







Designed as a "Mall within a Garden", various forms of rooftop greenery can be found within the shopping complex. Vertical greenery can also be found at the rooftop garden on the third floor near the amphitheatre. This extensive landscaping throughout the shopping complex façade provides patrons with beautiful spaces to immerse themselves in nature.
