To facilitate the redevelopment of Woodlands Checkpoint, the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) has appointed China State Construction Engineering Corporation Limited Singapore Branch (CSCEC) as the main contractor for the design and construction of the external infrastructure and associated works.

Please be informed that we will commence site hoarding and associated works at Marsiling Park to construct the external infrastructure works for the redevelopment of Woodlands Checkpoint. Affected amenities within Marsiling Park include the staircase, which will be closed from 15 December 2025, and the Ribbon Playscape, which will be closed from 31 December 2025.

How will this Impact Me?

Noise and dust are expected during this period. We seek your kind understanding as these essential works are necessary to support the progress and timely completion of the infrastructure works. Please be assured that every effort will be made to minimise any inconvenience to park visitors and nearby residents throughout this period. Marsiling Park and the carpark area will remain operational; however, parking spaces will be limited as a section of it will be occupied by the construction works.

Mitigation Measures

Localised noise barriers will be installed around the affected machinery, and the work area will also be hoarded up to ensure safety and minimise inconvenience to park visitors.
