Origin: From Indo-China, Southeast

Asia to Australia

Light-grey and fissured



Twigs

 Young shoots have raised lenticels



Young shoots have pale raised lenticels, tomentose


Foliage


Delonix regia

- Bipinnate compound leaves, feathery
- Leaflets oblong, 0.8-1.2 cm
 (L) × 0.2-0.4 cm (W)
- Leaf-like stipules found on young foliage

Peltophorum pterocarpum

- Bipinnate compound leaves
- Leaflets oblong, 1-2 cm (L) × 0.3-1 cm (W)
- Small, linear stipules found on leaf buds





Character comparison

Flowers

Delonix regia

Peltophorum pterocarpum

- Scarlet-red
- Petals 4-6 cm in length



- Yellow
- Petals 1.5-2.5 cm in length



Fruits

- Brown to black when ripe, strap-shaped, 30-70 cm (L) × 5-8 cm (W)
- Split open when ripe (dehiscent)
- 20-50 seeds, transversely positioned in each pod
- Purple-brown when ripe, oblong-elliptic, 5-14 cm (L) × 2-3 cm (W), winged on edges
- Do not split open (indehiscent)
- 1-5 seeds, longitudinally positioned in each pod
